### Le Bar du Bouillon

The concept of Bouillon Racine, a Belle Epoque landmark created in 1906, is "to serve food and wine at affordable prices in a convivial atmosphere." Now, at the next-door "Bar du Bouillon Winemaker's Bar," they're sending out, say, excellent taramas from Comptoir du Caviar (€9), Crevette ravioli in a bouillon, ginger, crustaces (€7), Eric Kayser's excellent bread, delicious home-made desserts (Tiramisu, Œuf à la neige), and Maison Pedone ice creams (€3 per boule). Choose from 250 French and Corsican wines (like Clos Canarelli White, €58), mocktails, cocktails, cheering Mulled wine, beers etc.
