

Dinner and a Party

Discreetly located on Avenue Kléber is the recently opened restaurant, Masha. The restaurant and bar offers diners a contemporary menu of both French and Japanese cuisine, satisfying the tastes of many visitors and perfect for when everyone in a group feels like eating something different. Start with the simple salad drizzled with a sweet and tangy sesame vinaigrette or perhaps the foie gras before enjoying mains that include sushi platters, roasted chicken and the Homard Flambé, the house star dish that is flambéed at your table. Masha offers a great ambiance for a fun dinner in the city, but its secret is that it also boasts a speakeasy piano bar taking your evening to the back where the music and party starts, and keeps going until 2am. - S.I.

Wine Bar Meets Tapas Bar

In the quintessentially Parislan neighbourhood of Odéon is where the Bar du Bouillon awaits with a very cosy welcome. When visiting Paris many visitors cannot wait to sample some of France's wines and here is a great little find to do so with the menu boasting an impressive wine list with over 250 drops to discover, ranging from the very traditional to a new generation of biodynamic wines including Stéphane Tissot's chardonnay. To accompany the smooth wine appreciation night out, the bar serves a refined Frenchstyle tapas menu that matches beautifully with the wines. Order the fole gras, the truffled ham or the black rice risotto with green asparagus and matured Comté cheese with bite and let the staff guide you with the wine pairing. The bar is open daily and offers the possibility of ordering heartier dishes from the Bouillon Racine restaurant next door, a Parisian Institution in French fare. - 5.1.
